

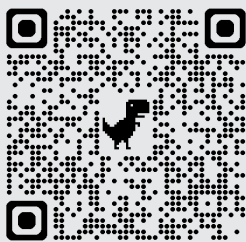
Web Accessibility Compliance Checklist

Does your course comply?

The Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) mandates that digital information and communication be accessible to people with disabilities. It has adopted the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0 (A & AA) to ensure web content is perceivable, operable, understandable, and robust.

This checklist is intended as a resource to assist faculty and staff in ensuring their digital material is AODA/WGAC 2.0 compliant.

Written & Text-based Content



- Is your text structured so that it can be read from left to right, top to bottom, while still making sense? WCAG 2.4.3
- Do your site pages have titles that describe the topic or purpose of the content? WCAG 2.4.2
- Do your headings and labels describe the topic or purpose of the content below? WCAG 2.4.6
- Is the purpose of your hyperlinks clear from the link text itself or the surrounding context? WCAG 2.4.4
- Is your site navigable using keyboard access only? WCAG 1.3.2

Diagram & Image Content



- Have you provided alt-text for all images and diagrams? WCAG 1.1.1
- Have you made sure that your content doesn't rely solely on colour to convey meaning? WCAG 1.4.1
- Is there a high contrast between your text and its background? WCAG 1.4.3
- Are you using real text rather than images containing text? WCAG 1.4.5

Audio & Visual Content



- Do you have captions available on your media? WCAG 1.2.2
- Do you have a text transcript available for any audio only content? WCAG 1.2.1
- Do you have a text description for any video only content? WCAG 1.2.1
- Have you eliminated any content that flashes more than three times in any one-second period? WCAG 2.3.1
